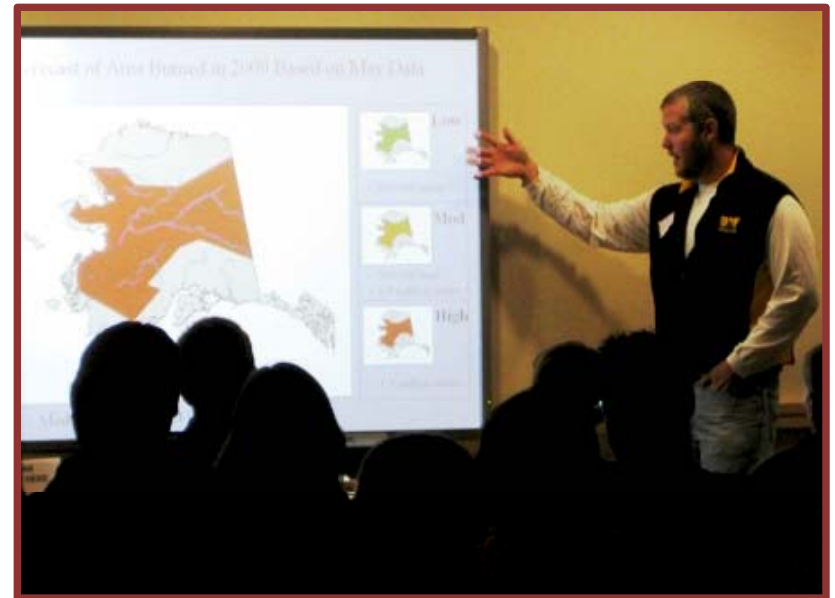

- Open discussion on communication of fire science information



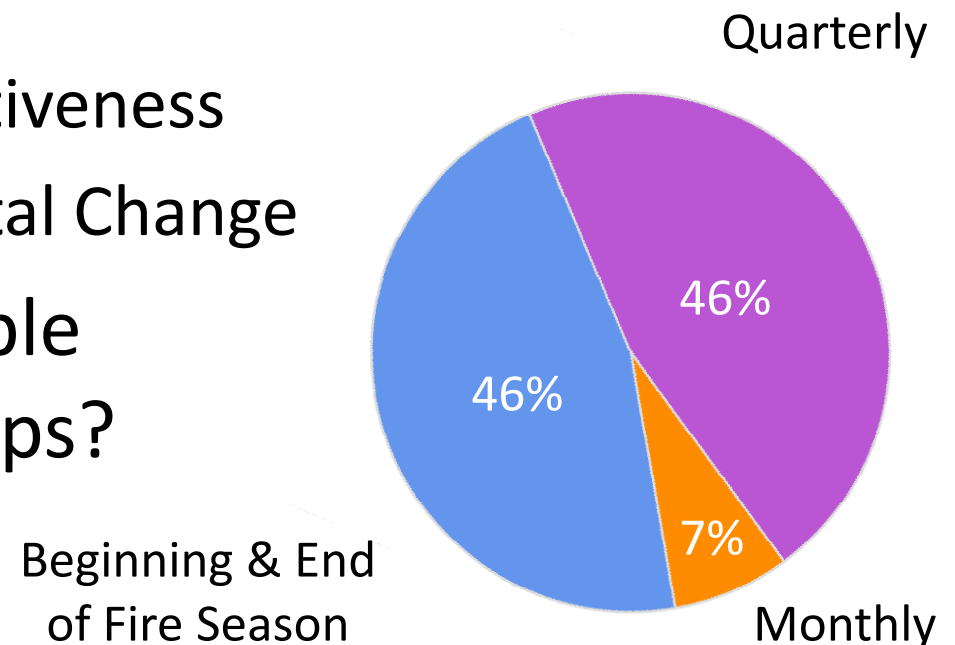
Summary of 2009 Technology Transfer Survey Results

email



Summary of 2009 Technology Transfer Survey Results

- Top 5 most relevant/interesting fire science topics
 1. Fire Danger
 2. Fire Behavior
 3. Risk Management
 4. Fuel Treatment Effectiveness
 5. Climate/Environmental Change

Summary of 2009 Consortium Workshop Evaluation

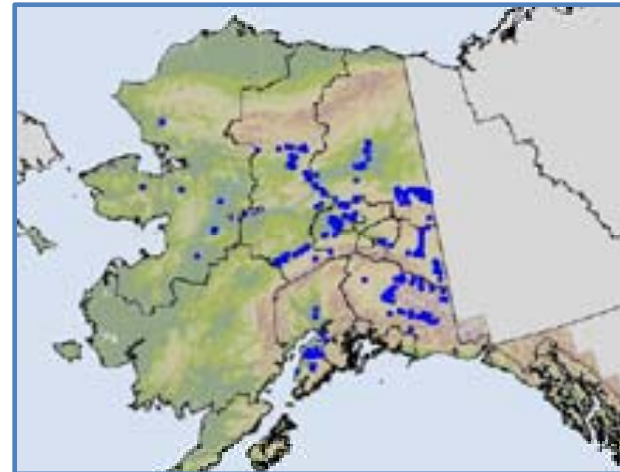
