

Chris Moore demonstrates how to access the BUI Season Tracker on the Predictive Services Fuels/Fire Danger page. The accompanying screen capture does not match exactly with what he is saying, but follows the same steps (listed below)

1. Go the AICC website: <https://fire.ak.blm.gov/aicc.php>
2. Under the “Predictive Services” section click on “Fuels/Fire Danger”
3. On the map of Alaska on the right, click on the red dot (“stop light”) for the PSA of interest
4. Scroll down to see data for each station in the PSA
5. The date range can be changed at the top of the page (default start is May 1, so Chris talks about changing this to March 1 and looking for a station [Delta] where data are already being collected on March 29)
6. The black line is the current season data, while blue and red lines are average and maximum BUI over the period of record for the station (“Stat. Span” on upper left of each plot)
