

# Fire Regime and Condition Class (FRCC) Standard Landscape Application Software Installation/Upgrade Notes Version 1.3.2.4

## FRCC Software Installation Notes

The FRCC Field Software version 1.3.2.4 can be installed (or upgraded from a previous version) with the following steps:

1. **Install Microsoft Access if needed.** The FRCC database was developed as a Microsoft Access 2000 database. The FRCC application will run with Microsoft Access 2000 or a later version of Microsoft Access. The FRCC application also appears to interface properly with Microsoft Access 97.
2. **Download the FRCC Standard Landscape Application Software install file** from the FRCC website at [www.frcc.gov](http://www.frcc.gov). The FRCC Field Software install file is called `FRCC_StdLndscp_Wrksht_setup_windows_1_3_2_4.exe` and can be downloaded by clicking on the *Tools and User Documents* link, then on the *FRCCSA* link. (On [www.fire.org](http://www.fire.org), download by clicking on the *NIFTT – Downloads* menu, then on the *FRCCSA\_1.3.2.4* link. The file is still called `FRCC_StdLndscp_Wrksht_setup_windows_1_3_2_4.exe`.)
3. **Install the FRCC software** by running `FRCC_Field_setup_windows_1_3_2_4.exe`.
4. While the installation package is running, a dialog will be displayed asking if you want to “Would you like to import an FRCC database from an installation prior to version 1.2.2.3?” Click on *No*. Then click *OK* in the window that says “Could not connect to FRCC National Database,” then click *OK* in the window that says, “Unable to connect to FRCC National Database. Did not update local database lookup tables.” (This set of messages is left from a version of the software which used an online database, instead of a copy that is downloaded with the software.)
5. From [www.fire.org](http://www.fire.org), **download the FRCC Software Application Database** by clicking the link *FRCC\_Std\_Database* on the *NIFTT Downloads* page (right below the download link for the *FRCCSA* software). Open **Windows Explorer** to the folder in which the software is installed (default is: `C:\FRCCStdLndscpWrksht`), rename the old `frcc.mdb` to “`frcc_old.mdb`” and paste the new `frcc.mdb` into the folder. The FRCC Software Application Database contains Refresh, LFNAT, Rapid Assessment and Guidebook BpS Models.
6. If you previously had installed an older version of the FRCC software and had created a shortcut on the desktop to the `frcc.jar` self-executing jar file, remove that shortcut so you don’t accidentally run the old version of the software.
7. **Start the FRCC Standard Landscape Software** by clicking on the windows start button, then clicking on Programs, then “Fire Regime Condition Class”, then “FRCC Standard Landscape – Worksheet
