In addition to natural fire effects, human modification or attempted modification of fire behavior, through suppression, vegetation management, prescribed fire, and other activities also affect wildlife and their habitat. Understanding the complex positive and negative impacts of fire and fire-related management actions on California’s fish, wildlife, and plants is vital to future conservation and management planning.

- Review papers
- Commentaries or Essays that provide well-argued and well-documented personal perspectives
- Book reviews on recent books that have been published on the topic
